Sec. 22 of the Building & Other Construction Workers (RE&CS) Act, 1996, empowers the Andhra Pradesh Building & Other Construction Workers Welfare Board, Hyderabad, which was constituted under the provisions of the Act, to provide certain welfare measures and facilities to the building and other construction workers.

The Commissioner of Labour through the letter 2<sup>nd</sup> cited has submitted a proposal to evolve Marriage Gift scheme providing financial assistance of Rs.5,000/- to the registered unmarried women workers / daughters of beneficiaries of the Board, as socio-economic measures and also to discourage the practice of child marriages among worker groups.

After examination, the Government hereby approve the scheme under sub rule (L) of Rule 33 of A.P. Building & Other Construction Workers Welfare Rules, 1999, read with Sec.22 of the Building & Other Construction Workers (RE&CS) Act, 1996, for providing financial assistance of Rs.5,000/- (Rupees five thousand only) to the registered unmarried women workers / upto two daughters of beneficiaries of the Board with the following guidelines.

- (A) The Board shall implement the scheme providing of Rs.5,000/- as financial assistance under the scheme for purchase of gift article.
- (B) The Board shall extend the benefit to the registered unmarried women workers / daughters of beneficiaries of the Board, who have completed the age of 18 years.
- (C) The Board shall release the benefit after obtaining the attested copies of age proof certificate, Marriage Registration Certificate, Wedding Invitation and photos etc., along with application.
- (D) The Deputy Commissioner of labour shall obtain enquiry report from Assistant Labour Officers concerned.
- (E) The Board shall release the marriage benefit scheme of Rs.5,000/- towards gift, to the savings bank account of bride.

- (F) The application for claim shall be submitted to the Deputy Commissioners of Labour in the format appended to this order.
