Labour, Employment, Training & Factories Department – The Building and other Construction Workers (RE&CS) Act, 1996 – Implementation of Welfare Schemes by the Telangana Building and Other Construction Workers Welfare Board – Scheme to provide relief for temporary disabilities (due to accident / disease) to the registered building & other construction workers – Enhancement of amount from Rs.1,500/- per month to Rs.3,000/- per month – Orders – Issued.

ORDER:

In the G.O. 1st read above, the Government of Andhra Pradesh has approved the scheme of providing Temporary Disability (due to accident / disease) relief to the building & other construction workers for Rs.1,500/- per month.

2. In the letter 3rd read above, the Commissioner of Labour, Telangana has submitted a proposal based on the resolution made in the 2nd Board meeting of the Telangana Building & Other Construction Workers' Welfare Board held on 31.03.2015, for enhancement of the existing amount @ of Rs.100/- per day and maximum of Rs.1,500/- per month to Rs.200/- per day and maximum of Rs.3,000/- per month which may extend upto 3 months towards relief for temporary disabilities (due to accident / disease) to the registered building & other construction workers w.e.f. 01.05.2015.

3. In the circumstances reported by the Commissioner of Labour, Telangana, Hyderabad and after careful examination of the proposal, Government hereby order to enhance the existing amount of Rs.100/- (Rupees hundred only) per day and maximum of Rs.1,500/- (Rupees one thousand and five hundred only) per month to Rs.200/- (Rupees two hundred only) per day and maximum of Rs.3,000/- (Rupees three thousand only) per month which may extend upto 3 months towards relief for temporary disabilities (due to accident / disease) to the registered building & other construction workers in terms of sub Rule (L) of Rule-33 of the Andhra Pradesh Building and Other Construction Workers (RE&CS) Rules, 1999 read with section 22 of the Building & Other Construction Workers (RE&CS) Act, 1996, with the following guidelines w.e.f. 01.05.2015:-

- (i) The Scheme is applicable to the registered building and other construction worker as a beneficiary with the Board.
- (ii) If the registered Building and Other Construction Worker is hospitalized for 5 (five) or more days due to accident or any disease, he / she is entitled for sanction of this benefit.
- (iii) The financial assistance shall be @ Rs.200/- (Rupees two hundred only) per day and maximum of Rs.3,000/- (Rupees three thousand only) per month. If the hospitalization / disability continue due to disease like heart ailments, kidney failure, cancer or any other such terminal disease on production of a certificate from the Medical Officer concerned. The Board may extend the relief up to 3 months @ Rs.3,000/- (Rupees three thousand only) per month.

- (iv) The enhanced amount under the relief is applicable only on the hospitalization on or after 01.05.2015.
- (v) If any registered workers is in receipt of any benefit from other welfare and social security scheme, for the same cause, he / she will not be eligible for relief under this scheme except such patients getting treatment of the injuries due to accident / any such disease under the Rajiv Arogyasri Scheme.
- (vi) The registered worker shall submit prescribed application form to the concerned officer along with Medical Certificate issued not below the rank of Asst. Civil Surgeon of the Government Hospital / Primary Health Centre.
- (vii) The Deputy Commissioner of Labour concerned shall obtain enquiry report from Assistant Labour Officers concerned and place before the District Scrutiny Committee for its scrutiny.
- (viii) After scrutiny, if found eligible, the eligible amount shall be released to the saving bank account of the registered building & other construction workers.
4. The Commissioner of Labour, Telangana, Hyderabad and the Secretary & Chief Executive Officer, Telangana Building & Other Construction Workers Welfare Board, Hyderabad shall take necessary action accordingly.
5. This order does not require concurrence of Finance Department as per rules in force.
