The Building and other Construction Workers (RE&CS) Act, 1996 – **TB&OCWWB – Schemes** – Implementation of Welfare Schemes by the Telangana Building and Other Construction Workers Welfare Board – Enhancement of the amount from Rs.10,000/- to Rs.20,000/- under the Marriage Gift Scheme to the unmarried women registered building & other construction worker and also to the two daughters of the registered building & other construction worker who have completed the age of 18 years – Orders – Issued.

ORDER:

In the G.O. 1st read above, the Government have issued orders to enhance the amount from Rs.5,000/- (Rupees five thousand only) to Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) under Marriage Gift Scheme to the unmarried registered women building & other construction worker and also to the two daughters of the registered building & other construction worker who have completed the age of 18 years in terms of sub Rule (L) of Rule-33 of the Telangana Building & Other Construction Workers (RE&CS) Rules, 1999 read with Section 22 of the Building & Other Construction Workers (RE&CS) Rules, 1996, with certain guidelines prescribed therein.

2. In the circumstances reported by the Secretary & CEO, Telangana Building & Other Construction Workers Welfare Board, Hyderabad in the reference 2nd read above, Government after careful examination of the proposal, hereby order to enhance the existing amount from Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) to Rs.20,000/- (Rupees twenty thousand only) under Marriage Gift Scheme to the unmarried registered women building & other construction worker and also to the two daughters of the registered building & other construction worker who have completed the age of 18 years in terms of sub Rule (L) of Rule 33 of the Telangana Building and Other Construction Workers (Regulation of Employment & Conditions of Service) Rules, 1999 read with Section 22 of the Building and Other Construction Workers (Regulation of Employment and Conditions of Services) Act, 1996 with the following guidelines:-

- (a) The Board shall implement the scheme providing of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees twenty thousand only) as a Marriage Gift to the unmarried women registered building & other construction worker and also to the two daughters of the registered building & other construction worker who have completed the age of 18 years.
- (b) The enhanced amount of marriage gift is applicable only to the marriages that took place on or after issue of the Government Orders.
- (c) The beneficiary amount of this scheme is in addition to any other such similar schemes of the Government.
- (d) If both the parent is happened to be registered building & other construction workers, the scheme amount shall be only to either of the parent.

- (e) The beneficiary shall submit prescribed application form along with xerox copy of BOC card, any document in support of age proof, xerox copy of the AADHAR card, wedding invitation card and photos of marriage to the concerned officer within 1 year from the date of marriage.
- (f) The Deputy Commissioner of Labour shall obtain enquiry report from the concerned Assistant Labour Officer and place before the District scrutiny committee for its scrutiny.
- (g) After scrutiny, if found eligible, the scheme amount of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees twenty thousand only) shall be released to the Saving Bank Account of the beneficiary.
3. The Commissioner of Labour, Telangana and the Secretary & Chief Executive Officer, Telangana Building & Other Construction Workers Welfare Board, Hyderabad shall take necessary action in the matter accordingly.
4. This order does not require concurrence of the Finance Department as per Rules in force.
