ABSTRACT

Labour, Employment, Training & Factories Department – The Building and other Construction Workers (RE&CS) Act, 1996 – Implementation of Welfare Schemes by the Telangana Building and Other Construction Workers Welfare Board – “Maternity Benefit Scheme” for the registered women workers, wife & two daughters for two deliveries each of beneficiaries of the Board – Enhancement of amount from Rs.20,000/- to Rs.30,000/- – Orders – Issued.

ORDER:

In the G.O. 1st read above, the Government have issued orders to enhance the amount from Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) to Rs.20,000/- (Rupees twenty thousand only) towards “Maternity Benefit Scheme” for the registered women workers, wife & upto two daughters up to two deliveries of beneficiaries of the Board in terms of sub rule (L) of Rule-33 of the Telangana Building and Other Construction Workers (RE&CS) Rules, 1999 read with section 22 of the Building & Other Construction Workers (RE&CS) Act, 1996, with certain guidelines prescribed therein.

2. In the circumstances reported by the Commissioner of Labour & Member Convenor, Telangana Building & Other Construction Workers Welfare Board, Hyderabad in the letter 2nd read above, Government after careful examination of the proposal, hereby order to enhance the existing amount under “Maternity Benefit Scheme” from Rs.20,000/- (Rupees twenty thousand only) to Rs.30,000/- (Rupees thirty thousand only) of this an amount of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) in lump sum will be paid to the women registered Building & Other Construction Workers in the 7th month of her pregnancy to compensate the wage loss during 7th to 9th month of her pregnancy. The balance amount of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees twenty thousand only) will be paid after delivery for the registered women workers, wife & two daughters for two deliveries each of beneficiaries of the Board in terms of sub rule (L) of Rule-33 of the Telangana Building and Other Construction Workers (RE&CS) Rules, 1999 read with section 22 of the Building & Other Construction Workers (RE&CS) Act, 1996, with the following guidelines w.e.f. 01.05.2017:-

- (a) The scheme is applicable to the registered building and other construction worker.
- (b) The worker is eligible under the Maternity benefit scheme only after completion of 12 months of registration period i.e from the date of registration to the date of delivery.
- (c) The scheme amount shall be paid as follows:-
 - (1) Rs.30,000/- (Rupees thirty thousand only) for each delivery limited to two deliveries, of this an amount of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) in lump sum shall be paid to the women registered building & other construction worker in the 7th month of her pregnancy to compensate the wage loss during 7th to 9th month of her pregnancy. The balance amount of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees twenty thousand only) will be paid after delivery.

- (2) For each delivery limited to two deliveries to the wife of the male registered worker and also;
- (3) For each delivery limited to two deliveries to the two daughters of the either male or female registered building & other construction worker.
- (d) The enhanced amount of maternity benefit is applicable on or after **01.05.2017**.
- (e) The beneficiary amount of this scheme is in addition to any other such similar schemes of the Government.
- (f) The applicant shall submit prescribed application form to the concerned officer along with Delivery Certificate issued by PHC/ Local area hospital or Medical Officer of the Pvt. Hospital / Certificate of Panchayat Secretary in case of pre-home delivery in a Village and also a Birth Certificate issued by the appropriate authority.
- (g) The claim application along with the above documents shall be submitted within 1 year from the date of delivery.
- (h) The Deputy Commissioner of Labour concerned shall obtain enquiry report from Assistant Labour Officer concerned and place before the District Scrutiny Committee for its perusal.
- (i) After scrutiny, if found eligible, the scheme amount shall be released to the saving bank account of the beneficiary.
3. The Commissioner of Labour, Telangana & Member Convenor, Telangana Building & Other Construction Workers Welfare Board, Hyderabad shall take necessary action in the matter accordingly.
4. This order does not require concurrence of the Finance Department as per Rules in force.
