Labour, Employment, Training & Factories Department – The Building and other Construction Workers (RE&CS) Act, 1996 – Implementation of Welfare Schemes by the Telangana Building and Other Construction Workers Welfare Board – Scheme to provide relief for temporary disabilities (due to accident / disease) to the registered building & other construction workers – Enhancement of amount from Rs.3,000/- per month to Rs.4,500/- per month – Orders – Issued.

ORDER:

In the G.O. 1st read above, Government have issued orders to enhance the amount from of Rs.100/- (Rupees hundred only) per day and maximum of Rs.1,500/- (Rupees one thousand and five hundred only) per month to Rs.200/- (Rupees two hundred only) per day and maximum of Rs.3,000/- (Rupees three thousand only) per month which may extend upto 3 months towards relief for temporary disabilities (due to accident / disease) to the registered building & other construction workers in terms of sub Rule (L) of Rule-33 of the Telangana Building and Other Construction Workers (RE&CS) Rules, 1999 read with section 22 of the Building & Other Construction Workers (RE&CS) Act, 1996, with certain guidelines prescribed therein.

2. In the circumstances reported by the Commissioner of Labour & Member Convenor, Telangana Building & Other Construction Workers Welfare Board, Hyderabad in the reference 2nd read above, Government after careful examination of the proposal, hereby order to enhance the relief amount under the welfare scheme "Hospitalisation Relief Scheme" from Rs.200/- per day subject to maximum of Rs.3,000/- per month to Rs.300/- per day subject to maximum of Rs.4,500/- per month which may extend upto 3 months for temporary disabilities due to accident / disease to the registered building & other construction worker in terms of sub rule (L) of Rule 33 of the Telangana Building and Other Construction Workers (Regulation of Employment & Conditions of Service) Rules, 1999 read with Section 22 of the Building and Other Construction Workers (Regulation of Employment and Conditions of Services) Act, 1996 with the following guidelines:-

- (a) The Scheme is applicable to the registered building and other construction worker.
- (b) If the registered building and other construction worker is hospitalized for 5 (five) or more days due to accident or any disease, he / she is entitled for sanction of this benefit.
- (c) The financial assistance shall be paid @ Rs.300/- (Rupees three hundred only) per day subject to maximum of Rs.4,500/- (Rupees four thousand five hundred only) per month. If the hospitalization / disability continue due to accident / diseases like heart ailments, kidney failure, cancer or any other such terminal diseases on production of a certificate from the Medical Officer, the Board may extend the payment of relief up to 3 months @ Rs.4,500/- (Rupees four thousand five hundred only) per month.

- (d) The enhanced amount under the relief is applicable on or after **01.05.2017**.
- (e) The registered worker shall submit prescribed application form to the Asst. Labour officer along with Medical Certificate issued not below the rank of Asst. Civil Surgeon of the Government Hospital / Primary Health Centre.
- (f) The Deputy Commissioner of Labour concerned shall obtain enquiry report from Assistant Labour Officer concerned and place before the District Scrutiny Committee for its perusal.
- (g) After scrutiny, if found eligible, the eligible amount shall be released to the saving bank account of the registered building & other construction worker.
3. The Commissioner of Labour, Telangana & Member Convenor, Telangana Building & Other Construction Workers Welfare Board, Hyderabad shall take necessary action in the matter accordingly.
4. This order does not require concurrence of the Finance Department as per Rules in force.
